



SEEKING A&P MECHANIC

Bario Aviation, Inc. is seeking a **full-time Airframe & Powerplant (A&P) Mechanic** to handle maintenance, inspections, repairs and modifications of aircraft, and to ensure that all aircraft remain in an air-worthy condition on a 24- hour as needed basis while possessing excellent interpersonal and communication skills.

Primary Duties Include

- Performing maintenance, inspections, repairs and modifications in accordance with FAA regulations, manufacturer recommendations and Bario Aviation's maintenance policies and procedures.
- Utilizing Bario Aviation's maintenance resources to accomplish tasks and optimize aircraft in-service time.
- Ordering parts, lubricants, etc. in sufficient quantities to ensure no aircraft downtime.
- Completing required documents in an accurate and timely manner.
- Complying with Bario Aviation's tool control and FOD policies.
- Maintaining and securing maintenance equipment at remote locations and on ramp areas.
- Maintaining all maintenance manuals.
- Demonstrating the ability to analyze problems and reach acceptable and workable solutions.
- Actively participating in quality assurance/improvement activities as directed by his/her supervisor.
- Ensuring that the shop/work/break areas are maintained in a safe and orderly manner.

Safety / Accountability Requirements

- Complies with all FAA and industry safety standards, OSHA regulations and Bario Aviation safety policies.
- Reports safety-related occurrences and safety hazards to supervisors in an appropriate and timely manner.
- Performs an array of physical duties such as dismantling, overhauling, repairing, fabricating, assembling, welding and erecting all parts of an aircraft.
- Puts tools and processes in place in a manner that will ensure optimal safety.
- Responds efficiently to after-hours and remote maintenance requests while on-call.
- Works in environments requiring heaving physical activity
- Provides all common hand tools required for the position.
- Possesses the ability to troubleshoot, isolate problems and make repairs in a safe manner.
- Accomplishes assigned work in a timely manner.
- Schedules and performs maintenance while considering factors such as work flow, location of equipment and personnel, tools, supplies, job requirements and weather.
- Must certify the quality of his/her workmanship, including signing mechanical flight releases for fieldwork.
- Interprets technical documents such as Maintenance Manuals, Airworthiness directives, Service Bulletins and Service Instructions.
- Maintains necessary paperwork and computer entries for any maintenance performed.

Safety / Accountability Requirements (cont.)

- Must test and inspect parts, subassemblies or completed assemblies.
- May be responsible for taxiing and towing aircraft for maintenance purposes.

Reports to / Supervises

- Reports directly to the Aircraft Maintenance Supervisor and/or the Director of Maintenance. No direct supervision is required. A&Ps who have worked for Bario Aviation for six months or longer are expected to teach and mentor other mechanics.
- A&Ps work collaboratively with pilots, flight instructors, staff, aircraft owners and students to accomplish the organization's mission and goals, and to ensure sufficient communication regarding aircraft status.

Fiscal Responsibility

- Candidate will search out opportunities to utilize his/her free time while on duty to improve his/her professional skills or to participate in company-related projects as assigned.
- Candidate will identify efficiency or cost-saving ideas in a timely manner to his/her immediate supervisor.

Teamwork

- Candidate will focus his/her efforts on supporting his/her co-workers at all times.
- Candidate will be tolerant of workplace diversity and will address co-workers respectfully at all times.
- Constructive criticism will be offered in a private setting and delivered in a positive and respectful manner.

Knowledge and Experience Required

- Valid Airframe & Powerplant (A&P) Certificate.
- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- Knowledge of Federal Aviation Agency (FAA) regulations.
- Two years of maintenance experience on appropriate type of aircraft. (may be waived on a case by case basis by the ownership)
- Ability to maintain tact and diplomacy skills in high stress situations.
- Knowledge of appropriate use of tools used for aircraft maintenance procedures.

Employment is dependent upon successful background check, security check and drug screen.
